TYRO

LAND-RANGER SERVICES CUP Presented to the licensed driver in the Tyro Trial with the lowest total score.

Dave Moore – CVLRC – 0 points and won on the run off sections

ESSEX LAND ROVER SHIELD Presented to the unlicensed driver under 18 years of age in the Tyro Trial with the lowest total score.

TALIESIN TROPHY Presented to the highest placed Standard Vehicle (Classes 1-5b) in the RTVT.

Dave White – CDLRC – 5 points

PIRELLI SCORPION CUP Presented to the driver in any class in the RTV Trial with the lowest total score.

LAND ROVER DISCOVERY CUP Presented to the highest placed Discovery in the RTVT.

NORTH WALES LAND ROVER CLUB DIESEL RTV TROPHY
Presented to the highest placed standard class diesel in the RTVT.

Dave White – CDLRC – 5 points

CAROL ROBERTS TROPHY Presented to the female driver in any class in the RTVT with the lowest total score. In the event of a tie, a run-off is to be called to decide a winner. This trophy was donated by Carol Roberts of the Breckland Land Rover Club in 1991.

Heather Pycraft – ELRC – 49 points

CHILTERN VALE LRC TROPHY for RTV Q class – awarded to the person with the lowest score in a Q class vehicle.

Clive Edwins – CVLRC – 18 points

TONY KEMPSTER SINGLE SECTION MEMORIAL CUP - awarded to a standard vehicle with the lowest score on one nominated section. The section to be nominated by the C o C prior to the trial commencing. In the event of a draw all names would go into a hat for a draw, as Tony believed in fate.

Section 12 – Matthew Pine – CDLRC – 0 points (there were 8 people with a clear on that section and it was a random draw)

LINCOLNSHIRE LRC RTV TEAM TROPHY

Presented to the highest placed nominated team of three in the National RTVT – lowest combined total score of the team regardless of class.

BRECKLAND LAND ROVER CLUB TROPHY. Presented to the club with the lowest average score in the RTVT. This is calculated by adding together the total scores of all entrants for a club and dividing by the number of entrants. A minimum of three entries are required for a club to be eligible for this trophy. Non-starters are not included but retirements are, with the highest available score for each section being awarded for all sections not completed.

COLBORNE TROPHIES PERPETUAL CUP Presented to the lady driver with lowest score in the CCVT irrespective of the class she is in.

Millie Roberts – BLRC – 30 points (13th Overall)

SENIORS CUP Presented to the driver, aged 55 - 64, with the lowest total score in the CCVT.

Steve Limb – LRLRC – 29 points (separated by clears from Simon Barden from Southern.

OLD CODGERS CUP Presented to the driver, aged 65 and over, with the lowest total score in the CCVT.

HQROA PIRELLI INTER CHALLENGE CUP Presented to the club NOMINATED driver in the CCVT with the lowest total score.

Combined Awards

NORTH YORKSHIRE/SOUTH DURHAM TROPHY Presented to the driver who achieves the best combined result in the CCVT and the Comp. Safari. This is best calculated by disregarding Classes and listing competitors in a first to last order of merit for each event. Each driver then receives the number of points equal to his position in the list (ties in score or time receive the same points) and the two scores are added. The lowest score wins. So a driver who is first overall in the CCVT and fourth overall in the Comp. safari would get five points and would be beaten by a driver who is second overall in both events (only four points).

OFF ROADER SPORTS SHIELD Presented to the driver who achieves the best result in the RTVT, CCVT and Comp. Safari. Standard Class. Each driver then receives the number of points equal to his position in the list (ties in score or time receive the same points) and the two scores are added together. The lowest score wins.
