## **GENERAL AND SCRUTINEERING & OFF ROAD COMMITTEE MEETINGS**

Please find enclosed with this letter copies of the ALRC EGM and S&ORC meetings minutes held on the 6<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and the agendas for the next meetings to be held at the Ibis Hotel, Dirft East, Parklands, Crick, Rigby, NN6 7EX starting at 10.00am and 13.00 on the 16<sup>th</sup> November 2019. There is adequate parking with free coffee provided. Food is able to be purchased but you may eat your own food in the meeting room if you prefer. You must register your vehicle at the hotel reception to avoid getting a parking fine.
