Nominations must be received on club headed paper from a member club with signatures from a proposer and seconder.

Members are reminded that to be elected on to either committee means a commitment to attend the meetings held three times a year at The Ibis Hotel Dirft East, Parklands, Crick, Rugby, NN6 7EX.

Free tea / coffee is available at the venue and it is possible to purchase food at lunch times. There is ample parking both in front and at the rear of the hotel.

Council meetings are held in February, June and October, General and S&ORC meetings are held in March, July and November. If you require any further information then please contact me.

Voting will take place at the meeting and votes for both committees will only be accepted from clubs that have paid their 2019 ALRC subscription prior to the meeting. The 2019 ALRC membership certificates will also be available to collect at the meeting.

Votes should be given by the club secretary or named delegate from the club.

A copy of the ALRC financial statement for the year ending 31st December 2018 will be available at the AGM where Richard Smith, ALRC Treasurer will discuss the financial statement.

May I also take this opportunity to remind competitive clubs that the rule change proposal previously circulated will also be voted on at the ALRC AGM and that the forms already issued to club secretaries can be returned to the above address, by email or in person at the meeting.

Club Membership Information

The ALRC Council at their meeting held on the 9th February 2019 discussed the delivery of club membership information to the ALRC as we know that many clubs had concerns on this matter and the following was agreed as a way of simplifying matters both for clubs and the ALRC.

All member clubs are required to keep up to date lists of their membership and the list must be made available to the ALRC should it be requested for, following any correspondence received by the ALRC from Companies House or similar legal body.

The ALRC does require the current name and address of club secretaries as a minimum, to be confirmed annually and any changes to this position should be notified immediately to allow for continuity of information between the ALRC and member club.
